


HEBREW






? Do you know what a model is? Find it and colour the picture according to how it really looks.

Do you know what a Hanukkah candlestick is and what it is used for? You'll find it high up in the museum, very near the ceiling. Use your imagination to draw what goes on it.


HANUKKAH CANDLESTICK




This picture is also missing an important decoration.
