Provenance: On May 21, 1944, the sketch was deposited as part of a wartime collection in Prague, in the so-called *Treuhandstelle*. Based on the transport number E 654 recorded on the NK card and the names on the back of the frame, it is evident that the last owner was Guido Hamburger himself.
